Skaters and Parents,

The Christmas Show Committee has adjusted the point system in order to so that the required point threshold is lower for our newest club members. Our points system is designed to showcase skaters of all skill levels and encourage members to fully participate in all aspects of our club, including everything from club activities all the way through competing at the highest levels in our sport. Opportunities are announced in club emails, so make sure we have yours!

To Qualify for a solo, duet, trio, or quartet you must meet the following criteria:

1. Be a member of the Ozark Figure Skating Club and have a membership in good standing
2. Meet the minimum threshold in Club Participation & Volunteer Hours (**See Chart Below**)
3. Fill out a points log before the due date

NOTE:

****Submitting a points form means you agree to participate in the Christmas Show in whatever role the Christmas Show Committee assigns you. If you are assigned a solo, duet, trio, or quartet for Christmas Show and withdraw under any circumstances, your eligibility for a solo, duet, trio, or quartet the following year is not promised, regardless of points earned, and will be determined by a committee vote.**

Dress Rehearsal will be on **December 1st**, 4:30-8:00pm.

Show day is **Saturday, December 5th!** Shows are at 11:00am, 1:00pm, 5:00pm.

Cast is required to be at the rink for EVERY show. **Cast must Check in is at 10:00am on Dec. 5th**

Lunch and a cast break room will be provided for the skaters between 3:00-4:00pm. We will also provide snacks throughout the day.

ATTENDING THE ENTIRE DRESS REHEARSAL AND ALL 3 SHOWS IS MANDATORY FOR ALL CAST MEMBERS!

Volunteer Requirement: All Group participants under 18 are expected to have a parent/guardian help with Set Up or Set Tear Down as well as one show.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

***Skaters must FULLY participate in each event to qualify for the points available and must fill out the points form appropriately to be counted towards the skater's total. You may only use dates/accrue points during the time in which you were a current member of Ozark Figure Skating Club.**

****Opportunities to earn points are at the discretion of the coaches and the Christmas Show Committee. If you have any questions regarding existing or potential opportunities, please reach out at Ozarkfigureskatingclub@gmail.com.**

*****Parents are not able to earn points for their skaters. Points are not transferable. Any volunteer hours used for points must be performed by the skater and cannot count double towards expected family volunteer hours.**

Awarding Solos, Duets, Trios, and Quartets

It is the desire of the club to align the Christmas Show performances with the distribution of skating talent our club has to offer. That being said, the following distribution applies to all skaters who turn in a points log and meet the above listed criteria.

NOTE: Anyone who attends **Sectionals** will automatically be awarded a solo the following year. However, you must meet the qualifying criteria listed including club participation/volunteer points minimum.

Anyone who is a **Graduating Senior** or is an **OFSC Coach** will be offered the opportunity to perform a solo (or duet/trio/etc) of their choosing.

In both of the above instances, a form will still need to be filled out.

THIS AGREEMENT INCLUDES A RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND WAIVER OF LEGAL RIGHTS AND DEPRIVES YOU OF THE RIGHT TO SUE OZARK FIGURE SKATING CLUB, JONES CENTER FOR FAMILIES, ARKANSAS FIGURE SKATING ASSOCIATION, AND OTHER PARTIES. DO NOT SIGN THE SIGNATURE PAGE UNLESS YOU HAVE READ IT IN ITS ENTIRETY. SEEK THE ADVICE OF LEGAL COUNSEL IF YOU ARE UNSURE OF ITS EFFECT. IN CONSIDERATION of Ozark Figure Skating Club ("OFSC"), The Jones Center ("JC"), and Arkansas Figure Skating Association ("AFSA") (collectively the "Released Parties") allowing me to participate in figure skating and related recreational activities or events in which OFSC, JC, or AFSA are in any way involved (the "Activities"), I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, parents, guardians, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Waiver and Release of Liability, Assumption of Risk, and Indemnity Agreement (the "Agreement"):

1. I hereby represent that I am in good health and proper physical condition to participate in the Activities. I agree that it is my sole responsibility to determine whether I am sufficiently fit and healthy enough to participate in the Activities, and that it is advisable to consult with a physician prior to engaging in the Activities to ascertain whether I am physically capable to do so.
2. I understand and acknowledge the physical rigors associated with the Activities are inherently dangerous and represent an extreme test of a person's physical limits and condition. I understand that participation in the Activities involves risks and dangers which include, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury, sickness and disease, permanent disability, paralysis and loss of life; loss of or damage to equipment/property; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents, contact or collision with other participants, spectators, vehicles, or natural or manmade objects; imperfect conditions existing on the ice skating surface and property where the Activities take place; equipment failure; inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the organizers of the Activities; and other undefined risks and dangers which may not be readily foreseeable or are presently unknown (the "Risks"). I understand that these Risks may be caused in whole or in part by my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the Activities, or the acts, inactions, or negligence of the Released Parties. I hereby expressly assume all such Risks and responsibility for any damages, liabilities, losses, or expenses which I incur as a result of my participation in the Activities.
3. I agree to be familiar with and to abide by all rules and regulations established by OFSC, JC or AFSA for the Activities in which I participate. I also accept sole responsibility for my own conduct and actions while

participating in these Activities and the condition and adequacy of any equipment that I might own and supply in conjunction with those Activities.

4. I hereby release, waive, and covenant not to sue, and further agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Released Parties, together with the organizers, promoters, sponsors, advertisers, hosts, venue and property owners upon which the Activities take place, and each of their respective parent, subsidiary and affiliated companies, officers, directors, partners, shareholders, members, agents, employees and volunteers, with respect to any liability, claim(s), demand(s), cause(s) of action, damage(s), loss or expense, including court costs and reasonable attorney's fees of any kind or nature ("Liability") which may arise out of, result from, or relate to my participation in the Activities, including claims for Liability caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the Released Parties.
