## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

1. All skaters with one performance should show up in full costume to the dress rehearsal.
2. Check in at the skate counter first thing.
3. Parents will be permitted into the Ready Rooms **before** and **after** Dress Rehearsal but not during. No parents/caregivers will be permitted into Locker Rooms at any time.
4. When dress rehearsal is over parents/caregivers will not be permitted to change their child(ren) in Ready Rooms (unless wearing a bodysuit at all times). Rink bathrooms are closed to changing.
5. The photos taken on dress rehearsal day will be free.

TIME	WHO	NOTES
3:30p	All solo, duet, trio, and quartet skaters arrive at the rink	Come dressed if possible. Rink bathrooms will be closed to changing and there is no locker room access until 4:30pm.
4:00p-4:30p	PHOTOS: solo, duet, trio, quartet skaters	Once ready, please gather in the rink lobby near the lockers. A volunteer or coach will direct you where to go and when. *if you are in a group performance you will be permitted to change starting at 4:30pm
4:30p	Group skaters arrive at the rink	Come dressed in your group costume. Rink bathrooms will be closed to changing and access to locker rooms is limited until 5:45pm when additional volunteers show up.
5:00p-5:45pm	PHOTOS: group skaters *groups will be called early if all members are present	Signs for your group will be posted on the rink glass. Wait with your group at the sign with your song title. Once your whole group is present you will be called for pictures.
5:45p-6:00p	ZAM	Parents/caregivers use this time to migrate upstairs. Dress Rehearsal will begin soon.
6:00p-6:30p	Warm-Up / Last Minute Practice	
~6:30p	1 <sup>st</sup> Run-through	
~7:30p	2 <sup>nd</sup> Run-through	
~8:30p	Individual Run-through as needed
